

NOTICE REGARDING THEFT OF FLASH DRIVE CONTAINING PATIENT INFORMATION

Under government health care programs, the Family Planning Council (the "Council") handles patient data on behalf of health care providers for reporting and billing purposes. The Council's office was burglarized, and one of the items stolen was a flash drive (also known as a "thumb drive" or a "memory stick") containing password protected patient information. This Notice provides information on how to determine whether your information may have been on the stolen flash drive, what steps you can take to protect yourself and what the Council is doing in response to this incident.
