

Concerta is a prescription medication containing methylphenidate, used to treat ADHD in children 6 years and older, adolescents, and adults up to 65 years. In 2025, Concerta remains a Schedule II controlled substance with strict prescribing regulations due to its potential for abuse and dependence.

Prescribing Concerta requires a thorough medical and psychiatric evaluation, including assessment of cardiac history and potential for tic disorders. The starting dose is typically 18 mg once daily in the morning, titrated weekly by 18 mg increments to a maximum dose of 72 mg per day in adults. Concerta tablets must be swallowed whole and not crushed or chewed.
