

Hydrocodone is a Schedule II controlled opioid medication used primarily for the management of moderate to severe pain. In 2025, strict regulations govern its prescription and dispensing to mitigate abuse and overdose risks. Hydrocodone combination products, often paired with acetaminophen or ibuprofen, are approved for pain relief but must adhere to dosage limits, including not exceeding 4 grams of acetaminophen daily to avoid liver toxicity.

Prescribers are required to perform thorough patient evaluations, including medical history, risk assessment, and continuous monitoring for signs of misuse or adverse effects. The FDA mandates participation in the Opioid Analgesic Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategy (REMS) to educate healthcare providers on safe prescribing practices. Controlled prescribing scenarios include limited supply durations, documentation through prescription drug monitoring programs (PDMPs), and using specific tools like morphine milligram equivalents (MME) to guide dosing.

Telehealth prescriptions for hydrocodone must comply with federal and state laws, requiring in-person evaluations or adherence to DEA telemedicine rules. Online purchase of hydrocodone is only legal through licensed pharmacies dispensing prescriptions from authorized providers.
