

Opana ER (oxymorphone extended-release) was an opioid analgesic used for managing severe, chronic pain that required around-the-clock opioid therapy. However, as of 2017, the FDA requested the removal of reformulated Opana ER from the market due to serious public health risks, including outbreaks of HIV and hepatitis C linked to injection abuse, as well as other severe adverse events. The FDA concluded that the risks of Opana ER outweighed the benefits and has taken steps to remove it from the market.

Due to this removal, Opana ER is no longer legally available by prescription or online as of 2025. Patients who were previously prescribed Opana ER are advised to work with their healthcare providers to find alternative pain management options.

Therefore, buying Opana ER online with limited or unlimited stock is not possible through legal and legitimate channels, given the FDA's market withdrawal and ongoing public health concerns.

In summary, Opana ER has been removed from the market for safety reasons, and it cannot be legally purchased online or otherwise in 2025
