

OxyContin is a Schedule II controlled-release opioid medication containing oxycodone, used for managing moderate to severe chronic pain requiring around-the-clock treatment. As of 2025, it remains tightly regulated due to its high potential for abuse and addiction.

Prescriptions for OxyContin require a valid, written or electronic prescription from a licensed healthcare provider who evaluates the patient's pain condition and risks. The FDA approved abuse-deterrent formulations of OxyContin to reduce misuse, and it is the only opioid of its kind with this labeling.
