Common Adult Dosage

| Form | Typical Dose | Maximum Daily Dose |
|---------------------------|-------------------------------------|--------------------|
| Immediate-Release Tablets | 50–100 mg every 4–6 hours as needed | 400 mg/day (max) |
| Extended-Release Tablets | 100–300 mg once daily | 300 mg/day (max)* |

*Extended-release is used for chronic pain only.

Pediatric Use

Tramadol is **not recommended** for children under 12 and should be used with caution in ages 12–17 only under strict medical guidance.

How to Take Tramadol Safely

- Take exactly as prescribed

- Swallow tablets whole — **do not crush or chew extended-release tablets**
- Avoid alcohol and sedatives
- Do not combine with other opioids or sleeping pills

Potential Side Effects

Common Side Effects
