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# What Is Xanax?

## Xanax (Alprazolam)

- Class: Benzodiazepine

Liquid Concentrate 1 mg/mL

## Typical Adult Doses (*doctor-supervised only*)

| Condition        | Common Starting Dose                                    |
|------------------|---------------------------------------------------------|
| Anxiety Disorder | 0.25–0.5 mg three times daily                           |
| Panic Disorder   | 0.5 mg once daily (XR) or 0.5 mg three times daily (IR) |

➡ Dose adjustments must be made by a **licensed clinician** only.

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## Proper Use Guidelines

- Take exactly as prescribed
  - Do **not** increase dose without medical guidance
  - Avoid alcohol — dangerous respiratory depression
  - Avoid driving or heavy machinery until you know effects
  - Do not stop suddenly — serious withdrawal risk
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## Side Effects of Xanax

### Common Side Effects

- Drowsiness
- Dizziness

- Slowed reflexes
- Fatigue
- Difficulty concentrating
- Dry mouth
- Memory issues

## **Serious Side Effects — Seek Medical Help Immediately**

- Severe drowsiness or difficulty waking up
- Breathing problems
- Severe confusion
- Suicidal thoughts
- Loss of balance
- Dependency symptoms

## **Risk of Dependence & Withdrawal**

Long-term or high-dose use can cause:

- Physical dependence
- Withdrawal symptoms (tremors, anxiety, seizures)
- Tolerance (needing higher doses)
- Addiction in susceptible individuals

Never stop Xanax suddenly — a healthcare provider must supervise tapering.

## **Interactions**

### **Avoid mixing Xanax with:**

- Alcohol
- Opioids (e.g., oxycodone, hydrocodone)

- Other sedatives
- Muscle relaxants
- Sleep medications
- Certain antidepressants or anticonvulsants

These combinations can lead to **respiratory depression, overdose, or death.**

- Beta-blockers (propranolol — for anxiety symptoms)

- Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy (CBT)
- Breathwork & meditation
- Exercise
- Sleep hygiene improvement
