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Overview

Phentermine is a prescription weight-loss medication that helps reduce appetite as part of a short-term treatment plan for obesity. It is often prescribed alongside diet, exercise, and behavioral modifications to assist adults with a Body Mass Index (BMI) of 30 or greater, or those with BMI 27 accompanied by weight-related health conditions. It is effective for appetite suppression, helping patients reduce caloric intake, thus promoting weight loss. It is not intended for long-term use due to risk of tolerance and dependence.

Phentermine stimulates the release of norepinephrine in the hypothalamus, the brain's appetite-control center. This stimulation increases sympathetic nervous system activity, suppressing hunger signals and reducing calorie intake. Its effect resembles that of amphetamines but is focused more on appetite inhibition than full stimulant effects.
